Glen Waverley Secondary College celebrates new facilities

Federal Member for Chisholm Anna Burke today joined the Glen Waverley Secondary College community in officially opening their new school facilities following a \$19 million redevelopment.

The overhaul of the school's infrastructure involved the construction of new buildings and the redevelopment of existing buildings housing the administration area, library, canteen, and subject areas including home economics, arts, science, commerce, graphic and fabric facilities.

Ms Burke said the completion of the project was cause for celebration.

"The College and the wider school community are to be congratulated on establishing the best possible facilities for their students and staff," Ms Burke said.

"These outstanding facilities will help ensure all students at Glen Waverley Secondary College are encouraged to realise their full potential and attain their goals.

"It's important for our students to take pride in their school and these new facilities reflect the school's commitment to providing its students with the best education possible," Ms Burke said.

The project, totalling over \$19.2 million, was funded through \$6.4 million provided by the Australian Government under its Capital Grants Program, \$9.9 million provided by the Victorian State Government and by a \$2.9 million contribution from the school community.

"Education is a huge priority for the Federal Government and I'm delighted our local schools like Glen Waverley Secondary College are benefiting from new and improved facilities," Ms Burke said.

Ms Burke was joined at the opening by Victorian Premier John Brumby and Mount Waverley MP Maxine Morand.
