## Opening of New School Building at Glendal Primary School

Federal Member for Chisholm, Anna Burke MP, has officially opened the new school building at Glendal Primary School, built as part of the Australian Government's Building the Education Revolution (BER).

Glendal Primary School received \$3,200,000 under the National School Pride (NSP) program and Primary Schools for the 21st Century (P21) element of the BER.

The BER is a key element of the Australian Government's \$42 billion Nation Building – Economic Stimulus Plan to support jobs, stimulate local economies and invest in important infrastructure for the long term.

Ms Burke congratulated Glendal Primary School on their new facilities which include six new classrooms, literacy, ESL offices and other learning spaces. The spaces will be used for the specialist teaching of science and technology, including robotics.

'We have now reached the next exciting phase in Building the Education Revolution,' Ms Burke said.

'It's fantastic that the principal, school staff, parents and tradespeople at Glendal Primary School have worked together to deliver this important project'.

Now that they are completed, teachers and students at Glendal Primary School will be teaching and learning in 21st Century facilities that they so richly deserve.'

'The new facilities will not only provide valuable opportunities for effective learning and innovative teaching practices, but enhance the school's capacity to provide high quality education, particularly in terms of science and technology subjects', School Principal, Ms Deborah Grossek said.

Speaking on behalf of the students, School Captains, Eiddwen Jeffery and Neehal Vilash were really pleased that the new building "...would make our school even better".

Ms Burke said the new facilities are not only a benefit to the school, but had provided local jobs.

'I am also delighted that this particular project has supported the employment of 141 workers. This is what we strived to achieve – this is the essence of the Economic Stimulus Plan,' Ms Burke said.
